Facility Expansion Continues on Parkland's Healthcare Campus

Located in Dallas County, the 2.8 million-square-foot Parkland campus is nearly twice the size of the old hospital, meeting the needs of the area's growing population.

As part of its commissioning services, Burns & McDonnell will conduct design reviews, observe construction performance, participate in equipment startups and test all systems to verify systems can operate efficiently and be maintained properly once construction is complete.
