Our world headquarters expansion produced work for more than 50 local businesses. Throughout the pandemic, nearly 70 employees were on-site at the project each day, navigating daily adjustments to the construction work sequence to maintain schedule and keep everyone working.

To keep a positive and healthy work environment, the Burns & McDonnell construction team implemented a staggered start time for work crews to implement social distancing, daily temperature checks of all labor on-site, multiple handwashing and sanitation stations available on all floors, virtual safety meetings and daily cleanings.

PHASE II EXPANSION PROJECT DETAILS

PROJECT DETAILS

- Using integrated design-build delivery, it took 13 months to build the 142,000-square-foot, four-story office building and 550-stall parking garage expansion.
- ► Throughout the more than 134,000 man-hours, there were no OSHA recordable injuries.
- ▶ Designed and built by Burns & McDonnell in partnership with VanTrust Real Estate.
- ▶ The new office building houses 776 office seats, increasing the size of the Burns & McDonnell world headquarters by 22%.
- ► The building frame was constructed with 813 tons of steel.
- ► The garage is composed of 395 precast concrete panels.
- ► The project came in under the \$42 million total budget.
- Project work awarded to minority- or women-owned businesses surpassed goals set at the beginning of the project.

ON-SITE AMENITIES

- ▶ 42 conference rooms and two large training rooms.
- ▶ Premium conference rooms with interactive features.
- All conference rooms include smart technology to increase efficiency and collaboration using web-based meetings.
- ▶ Adjustable desks allowing users to sit or stand.
- Areas customized with whiteboards and expansive counter space to inspire and accommodate various styles of collaboration sessions.

RECYCLING AND PRESERVATION

- Designed to sustainable best practices.
- ► Hackberry wood, native to the Midwest, used for cabinets, doors and trim materials.
- ▶ 100% LED lighting paired with daylight harvesting for optimal energy savings.
- Interactive messaging for electric vehicles alerting when the car is charged to avoid wasting electricity.
